LAND ACCESS HIGHLIGHTS:

A blanket permit for caches within **Mat-Su State Park** – managed state lands has been issued to GeocacheAlaska! Inc, for use by its members. This permit and its usage details will be posted online at the link below very soon. The **2011 Chugach State Park** (CSP) Geocaching Permit Number is 11-007. It must appear on your CSP cache container and on your cache listing page. Thanks to the Advocacy Committee members for working hard and complying with all the information requests to secure the permits which allow geocaching in Chugach State Park and in Mat-Su State Park units!

Photos may be downsized for submission, but be certain to save your original full-resolution photo where you can find it because that's the version we'll need to produce the calendar.

Thirteen photos will be displayed full-size on the calendar with at least one picture chosen from each category. The photo garnering the most overall votes will be placed on the cover.

By submitting your photo to this contest you grant GeocacheAlaska! Inc. the right to use and reprint the image on the calendar and the GeocacheAlaska! website. Photo credit will be given to the photographer. There is no compensation awarded to the contest winners. Winners get the honor of having their picture grace a monthly page or the cover of the calendar and the knowledge and happiness in knowing that their photograph was chosen to receive this honor.
